



When Dick Rosenthal retired as athletic director in 1994 after a lifetime of service to the University of Notre Dame, he was asked about the most memorable moment during his tenure. 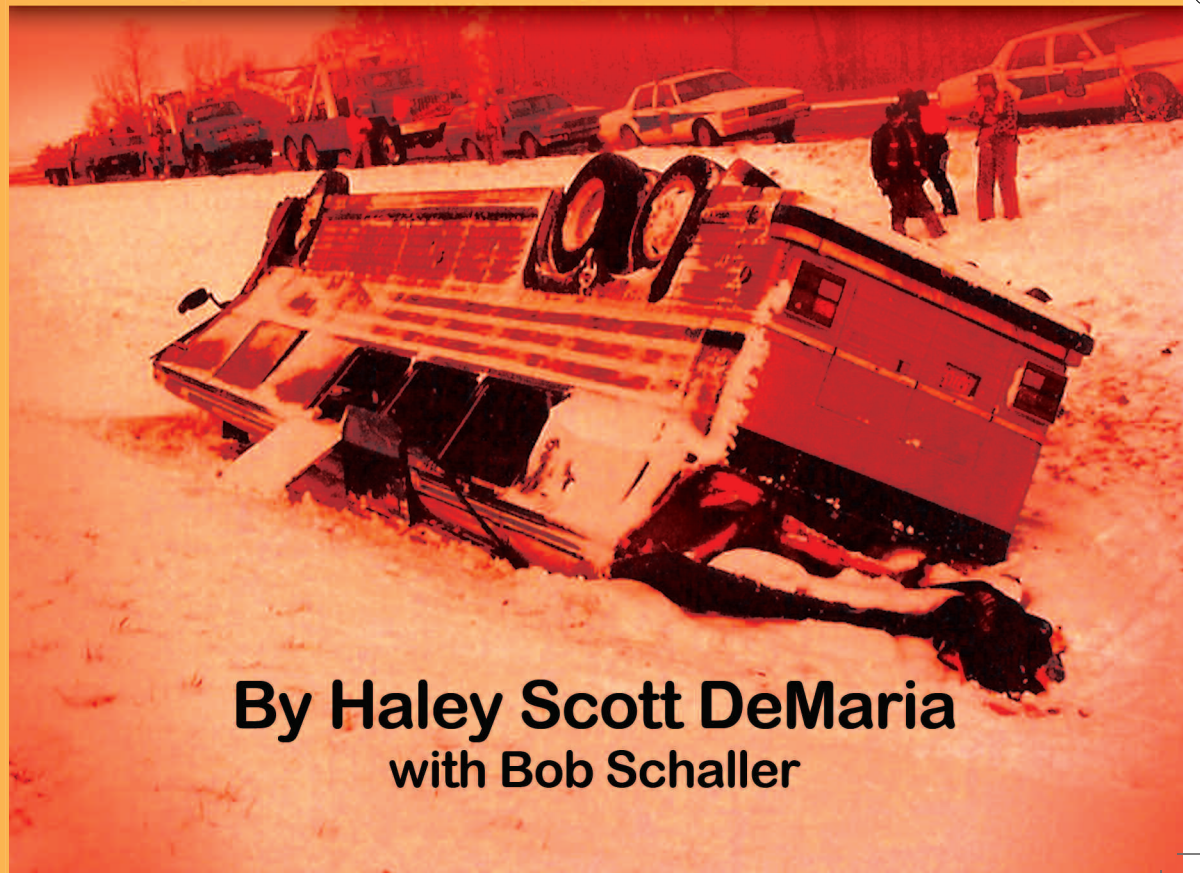
